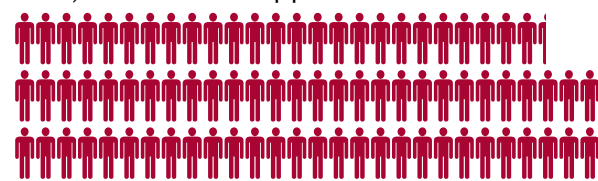
Alumni impact

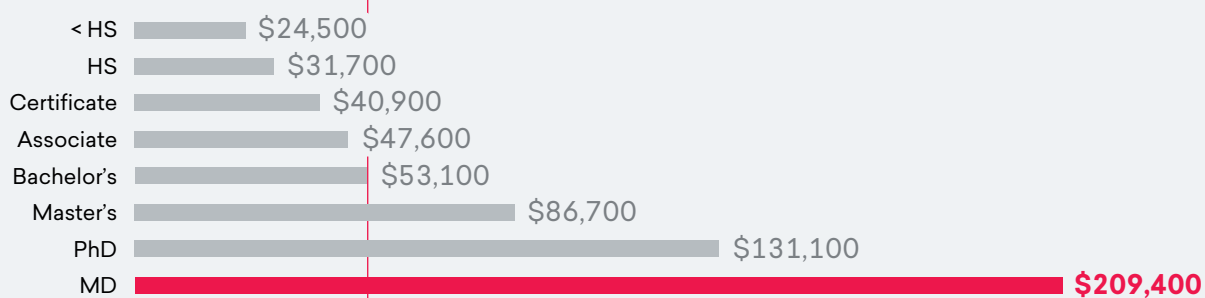
